













The first three kilometres of this walk are along the beautiful white sands of Cloudy Beach. At the end of the beach, the track follows a small creek inland before climbing a further three kilometres through bird-filled colourful heathland to East Cloudy Head. From here you'll get fantastic views along the south coast of Bruny Island to The Friars, and to the west and north-west over South Bruny to the southern ranges and Mt Wellington.

- 4 hours return
- l km 12 km return
- (P) Ample parking at start of track
 - Beach walk, then narrow bush track Park entry fee applies

Note: Clean dirt and mud from your boots before and after every bushwalk to prevent the spread of root rot

Please walk on the wet sand during spring and summer to protect nesting shorebirds, which lay their eggs amongst the beach debris
