Kingborough Council is seeking expressions of interest from community members to provide a community representative voice on the North West Bay River Project Management Group.

The Project Group will provide guidance and direction for the review of the current management plan, helping to identify key assets, management issues and community expectations within the North West Bay catchment area.

Council has engaged a consultant from Enviro-dynamics to work with the community to review and update the management plan which was written over 20 years ago. It's expected that the plan will take six months to develop starting from mid-September.

The revised management plan will provide an overview of the catchment's natural, economic and social structure, as well as identifying current and potential future threats to these assets. The plan will provide some advice and resources for natural resource management and a framework for on-ground works to proceed in a coordinated way.

Council welcomes expressions of interest from community members who have a passion for the area, local knowledge of the river and catchment and would like to join the Management Group.
