



# KINGBOROUGH RECYCLING GUIDE



## Put in the recycling bin:



### Aluminium & steel cans

Food & drink cans, including pressure packs & pet food cans. Clean aluminium foil and foil trays. Remove lids.



### Cardboard, newspapers, magazines, junk mail, phone books & office paper

Please do not secure in plastic bags or ties.



### Glass bottles & jars

Remove all lids. Please do not include broken drinking glassware, window glass.



### Plastic beverage, food & non-food containers & cartons

Margarine, ice-cream, yoghurt, shampoo & household detergent containers, plus containers with the 1-7 triangle (except no. 6 which is polystyrene such as styrofoam and meat trays). Rinse and remove lids.



Kingborough has two facilities which accept general and green waste, along with recycling. The Barretta Waste Management Facility and Bruny Island Waste Transfer Station are operated by Kingborough Waste Services. ## Leave out of recycling bin:



### Organic Waste

Green waste is accepted at the Barretta facility for recycling.



Drinking glass, window glass, light bulbs or broken glass.



Pizza boxes (dirty) & take away food containers  
Clean pizza boxes can go in the recycling bin.



### Food Scraps

Food scraps are compostable.



Meat trays, foam trays, polystyrene & foam



Ceramics, crockery, pottery, cookware & cutlery



Nappies & medical waste.



Hoses and cables, including electrical wire, chain, rope, string & fishing line.



Motor oil, acid, solvent or chemical containers



### Clothing & Shoes

If in good condition, donate to your local charity or to the Re-Use Shop.



### Plastic bags

Soft plastics (bread bags, shrink wrap) that you can scrunch in your hand can go to the REDcycle bin at Coles & Woolworths.



### E-waste & Electronic Appliances

E-waste, paint and batteries can be dropped off at Barretta for recycling.
