

















Follow the ridgeline higher and higher through open bushland and watch the water views across Storm Bay and North West Bay get better and better. The whole of Tinderbox Peninsula contains important white gum forest, which is a critical habitat for the threatened Forty-spotted Pardalote.

Dogs are prohibited from July to March due to Wedge-tailed eagle nesting season. Dogs are restricted to on lead and on formed tracks only from April to June. Please respect private property boundary signage.

- 1.5 hours return
- - 3.6 km return
- Limited parking at start of track. Horse float parking limited at the start of the trail off Estuary Drive.
- Gravel road, several steep sections, loose stones on track.

Note: Can combine with Peter Murrell Reserve Tracks for a longer walk or ride.
