# 1st Thursday of the month: Peggys Beach Reserve

A bushland reserve with water views over North West Bay to Bruny Island. Flat bush tracks meander through black peppermint forest. This site takes the program slightly further south past Margate. Access via Dickson Street, Electrona. Parking along Staff Road and Dickson Street. Meet at the reserve entrance marked by the blue star.






### 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of the month: Boronia Hill Reserve





### 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of the month: Coffee Creek Reserve
