About the Dave Burrows Walk This gentle walk meanders though woodland and coastal scrub with the path coming close to the mudflats and saltmarsh where many wading birds can be seen at low tide. The area has been rehabilitated by the local landcare group and is now a healthy strip of coastal habitat populated by many woodland birds and animals. There are good views of North West Bay along the track with several well positioned seats










Flax Iily

once established.






